2. No gum.
3. No jewelry.
4. No underwear under costumes.
5. Make-up can be applied at home.
6. No students wandering in the auditorium or hallways. If you are not on stage, you belong in the dressing room or the holding area. Please, no friends in the dressing rooms.
7. Do not bring valuables with you to rehearsal or performance.
8. No food or drinks in the auditorium.
9. No smoking on school grounds.
10. Keep dressing rooms neat. Use the garbage cans provided and keep personal items in your dance bags.
11. All seats are reserved. An usher will help you find your seat.
12. No video cameras allowed in the auditorium on recital night.

TIGHTS

We now have tights for sale in pink and tan. Sizes are limited. They are available on a first come, first serve basis. Please see someone at the desk if you need to purchase tights. Child sizes are \$7 and Adult sizes are \$9.

FAMILIES IN BOTH SHOWS

We have to vacate the building between the matinee and evening shows. You can either leave your costumes neatly in the dressing room or take them with you. Please do not leave valuables.
